MAGNET PROGRAMS APPLICATION DEADLINE

Attention 8th Graders applying for Magnet Programs

As we head into the Thanksgiving break, we wanted to remind you that the deadline to complete the magnet program application is Wednesday, December 1st by 11:59 PM. Remember this is your only opportunity to apply for the Magnet/IB Diploma Program, and we are excited that you have started the application process!

Here are a few more reminders:

- Please be sure you double check that you entered your teachers' names and email addresses correctly

 otherwise teachers will never receive the request and your application will not have the appropriate number of recommendation letters.
- While the student deadline to submit the application is December 1st, the deadline for teacher recommendations is January 15th. Please make sure your teachers know they have a little extra time to complete their recommendations in the best way possible.
- The "essay" doesn't need to be a five-paragraph essay. My best recommendation is about three paragraphs—enough to share your perspective about something important and demonstrate your ability to write coherently.
- The "Course Selection" tab is designed to let you tell us what classes you are taking this year—if you are in high school courses, advanced/AC courses, electives, and anything else that may be important to your classes this year.
- The last tab asks you to "Submit Application," and that's the last step to completing it. Please be sure you click that button in order to be in the applicant pool this year.


